PROGRAMS

AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

(2:30–5:45 M-F – through the school year)

This program includes regularly scheduled activities and classes, daily nutritious snack, daily help with homework, opportunities for recreation and/or practice times for those participating in the **ARTS ACADEMY** or other private lessons.

Private tutoring in Elementary and Middle School Subjects will be available on a pay per hour basis.

ARTS ACADEMY

(Weekly lessons scheduled by instructors)

Individual and group lessons are available in a variety of settings with qualified and experienced instructors. Currently offering:

Private lessons in:

Piano, Flute, Voice, Int. Guitar, Computer Art, Music Theory and Creative Writing

FEE SCHEDULE

AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

(Fee reductions and waivers for students in the **AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAM** will be considered based on income and family size)
Age restrictions – Kindergarten through 6th grade
Regular tuition - \$7.00 day/\$30.00 week (includes snack, homework assistance, and attendance in fine arts curriculum of the day)

Special Tutoring - \$8.00 per hour

Offering tutoring services for all Elementary, Middle, and High School Subjects

ARTS ACADEMY

(Fee reductions for students participating in the **ARTS ACADEMY** may be considered based on performance and/or income and family size)

Age restrictions vary according to instructor.

PRIVATE LESSONS - \$45.00 per month

Lessons available for Flute, Guitar, Piano, and Voice – Each weekly lesson will include 30 minutes with instructor and 15 minutes of theory on the computer. Days and times will be scheduled by the instructors.

GROUP LESSONS - \$35.00 per month

Forty-five (45) minute lessons available in music, guitar, music theory, vocal ensemble, creative writing, dance, drama and art.

SUMMER ARTS PROGRAM

ALL DAY PROGRAM - \$80.00 per week

HALF DAY PROGRAM - \$45.00 per week
